This database combines *Art Full Text* and *Art Retrospective*, providing coverage of art periodicals from 1928 to the present. and the addition to the Nelson-Atkins Museum of Art in Kansas City.

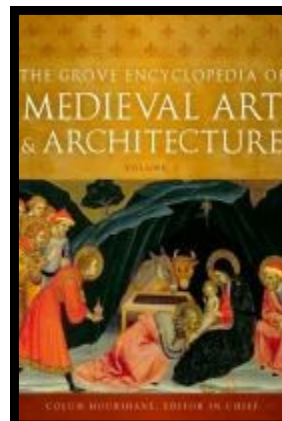

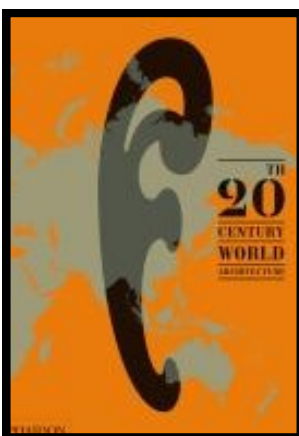
Complete work of the Dutch 17th century painter (1629-1667). Many color illustrations and extensive bibliography. (Vault)

Three-volume catalogue raisonné of Motherwell's paintings. Volume 1 contains essays and references, Volume 2 contains the paintings on canvas and panel, and Volume 3 contains collages on paper and paperboard.

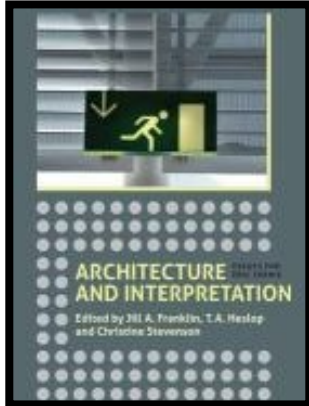
