This is a reminder that when you are entering Library facilities for a work shift, you need to wear a mask and have "access granted" status in the Safer Illinois app (or a current boarding pass). In addition, you should use your I-Card to swipe in, even if you are coming through the Marshall Gallery or another staffed but locked entry point.

Beginning Monday, we will have dedicated Wellness Support Associates (WSAs) checking entry at the Main Library Marshall Gallery, Grainger Engineering Library, and the Undergraduate Library, during hours that those buildings are open for services.
