Welcome to February, everyone! Just a few things to share today.

If you are wondering Do those who are vaccinated still have to get tested to get into buildings for the time being? The answer is yes.

As found on the university's <u>Vaccines For COVID-19 page</u>:

"Until the medical community has a better understanding of the impact of the vaccine in preventing disease spread, you still have to follow all university COVID-19 testing requirements. Currently, receiving a vaccine will not affect your building access status."

Also, CUPHD is beginning to offer vaccinations to University employees, including some staff here in the Library, who work in facilities or public service roles. The Library does not control the order or timing of vaccinations, but will continue to supply lists of employees to campus as requested. When eligible under the CUPHD process, you will be contacted directly and offered the opportunity to receive a vaccine.

On a separate note, we thought it was important to bring your attention to the email sent from System Human Resources last week (please see <u>Vacation and Sick Leave</u> <u>Changes for Overtime Exempt Civil Service Staff</u>). Civil Service Professional Exempt staff and Academic Professional staff will accrue and report all vacation and sick leave in the same way.
