Colleagues:

This update provides key information about several topics, in particular summer services. We will follow up with additional details as they become available, but please reach out if you have questions.

### **Summer Services**

- At the end of the spring semester, we will decrease our emphasis on e-Preferred collection development and fulfillment.
- We plan to stop making use of the HathiTrust Emergency Temporary Access Service (ETAS) on June 13th, in preparation for the start of the Summer II session.
  - Print collections will revert to previously set up loan periods and requesting policies.
  - HathiTrust in-copyright works will no longer be browsable.
- Initially, the following locations will be open for summer services:
  - Undergraduate Library: Mon-Fri 11:00-5:00
  - Grainger Engineering Library Information Center (GELIC): Mon-Thurs 11:00-9:00; Fri 11:00-5:00; Closed Saturday; Sun 3:00-9:00
  - Marshall Gallery pickup: Mon-Fri 10:00-5:00
  - We will add additional pickup locations over the summer and will announce those when known, along with related policy and procedures.
- We will continue to offer digitization options for partial works through Doc Express and entire works through Preservation Services as requested and as eligible.
- Print reserves will be available at both the Grainger Engineering Library Information Center (GELIC) and the Undergraduate Library this summer. Further details pending.

### **Fall Planning**

Our "Phase 4.5 and Phase 5" planning teams have been meeting and have prepared some general plans for sharing with the Dean.

### **Vaccines**

Now that all faculty, staff, and students are eligible for vaccination (see the [Massmail](#)), we encourage you to make an appointment (if you haven't already).
